Attorneys registered for CM/ECF can retrieve their bar admission information through our website.

1. Go to www.cafc.uscourts.gov/contact/attorney-admission-information, or select Attorney Admission Information under the Clerk's Office menu.
2. Click Attorney Admissions Search to open the search query.

Attorney Admissions Search

- There is no renewal fee for Federal Circuit attorney admissions.
- Attorney admission remains active as long as the attorney is in good standing with the court and has not been disciplined or sanctioned.
- The admission date for current Federal government attorneys will not reflect any previous private practice admissions date.
- If you have recently submitted your bar admission paperwork, please allow 10 business days for processing and for it to appear in the search results.
- Certificates are typically issued via US Mail within 90 days.

Last Name: *Required

First Name: Optional

Search tips: The Last Name is required, however if the First Name field is left empty, then all attorneys with the same last name will be displayed. You may use the wildcard character: * in your search query. For example, for all names starting with S use S*, for all names ending with a use *a, or if the name includes er use *er* in the search query.

Attorneys without CM/ECF accounts can either call the Clerk's Office at 202-275-8000 to retrieve this information or register for a CM/ECF account to be added to the search database.
