Federal Circuit Schedules April Session for the Minneapolis-Saint Paul Area

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit is pleased to announce that it intends to sit in Minneapolis and Saint Paul, Minnesota as part of its April 2019 session. The Federal Circuit will also hold its regular session in Washington, D.C.

Panels of the court will hear arguments at the following Minneapolis-Saint Paul area law schools and the federal courthouse:

Monday, April 1, 2019	University of St. Thomas School of Law (Minneapolis)
Tuesday, April 2, 2019	Warren E. Burger Federal Building & United States Courthouse (Saint Paul)
Wednesday, April 3, 2019	University of Minnesota Law School (Minneapolis)

The cases scheduled for the April 2019 session will be posted on the [court's website](#) once finalized. However, this special sitting of the court may be modified or postponed depending on the availability of an appropriation funding the operations of the court.

The Federal Circuit regularly hears arguments outside of Washington, D.C. as part of its nationwide jurisdiction and statutory requirement to provide "reasonable opportunities to citizens to appear before the court." Most recently, the Federal Circuit has held sessions in Chicago, Illinois; New York City, New York; Los Angeles, California; Boston, Massachusetts; Baltimore, Maryland; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and Wilmington, Delaware.
