

## Financial Hardship Policy

The conference fee schedules have been designed to address multiple categories of attendees, including those that cannot afford a full registration fee. Government and academic registration fees have been discounted. Afternoon sessions may be attended at no cost by registering for break-out sessions only.

Conference registrants who are still unable to attend sessions due to financial hardship may request an additional registration fee discount or waiver. A request for a reduced or waived fee should be emailed in advance of registration to: [CLERegistration@cafc.uscourts.gov](mailto:CLERegistration@cafc.uscourts.gov). The request must include the registrant's name, address, state bar ID number and state. The request should also state why the normal fee associated with the program causes the lawyer a financial hardship.

The Circuit Executive may waive or reduce the fee for any included CLE program upon a demonstration of good cause. Registration instructions will be provided separately to registrants upon the granting of a fee reduction or waiver.
