Step 2: <u>Link Legacy CM/ECF Account to a PACER Account</u>

New Electronic Filers and Account Maintenance

New electronic filing access and applications to the bar will be submitted through PACER. Register for electronic filing access <u>here</u>.

All changes to contact information and account maintenance will also be handled through PACER.

About NextGen CM/ECF

With the upgrade to NextGen CM/ECF, court filers now (1) have a redesigned and enhanced user interface; (2) no longer need to use a Java plug-in; (3) can use most common web browsers for filing; and (4) use a single sign-on for electronic filing and PACER access, as well as for all federal courts on NextGen CM/ECF.
