



## Emergency Filings

---

Counsel should advise the Clerk's Office as soon as possible about the following emergency items:

- Filing (or anticipated filing) of an emergency motion for stay or injunction under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 8 or 18;
- Filing (or anticipated filing) of an emergency writ of mandamus under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 21; and
- Erroneous filing of confidential or sealed materials in CM/ECF.

On weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (ET), please call the Clerk's Office at 202-275-8000 or email [emergencyfilings@cafc.uscourts.gov](mailto:emergencyfilings@cafc.uscourts.gov).

Counsel should include the following information:

- Counsel's contact information;
- When the document will be filed;
- Case information (Federal Circuit case number or lower court/agency information); and
- Brief description of the emergency request.
