PER CURIAM.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that:

(1) During any prolonged government closure, the court will remain open with essential staff to transact all business necessary to the progress and resolution of cases.

(2) Absent motion for an extension of time in a particular case, all court filing deadlines remain in effect. The court's CM/ECF system will remain in operation for the filing of all documents.

(3) All cases scheduled for oral argument, including but not limited to those involving government counsel, remain scheduled for oral argument. Counsel should not anticipate that any case will be removed from an argument calendar due to the government closure. Any motion filed in a particular case requesting rescheduling of an argument will be transmitted to the panel assigned to hear the case.
