ORDER

Extending Paper Filing Deadlines

Due to activity in the vicinity of the National Courts Building limiting the ability of mail and physical delivery of paper filings to the courthouse, the Clerk's Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit has been, and will be, inaccessible within the meaning of Fed. R. App. P. 26(a)(3), for the period of time beginning on June 5, 2020, through June 10, 2020. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. All deadlines for electronic filings in cases pending, or to be filed, in this court remain in effect.
2. All deadlines for paper filings in cases pending, or to be filed, in this court expiring on or between June 5, 2020, and June 10, 2020, are extended to June 11, 2020. The Clerk of Court shall deny as moot any motion for an extension of time that is obviated by the effect of this Order.
3. For purposes of this Order, "paper filings" includes only case-initiating documents filed in paper by pro se parties pursuant to Fed. Cir. R. 25(b)(1), all other filings by pro se parties filed in paper pursuant to Fed. Cir. R. 25(c)(2), and any paper filings required of represented parties requested by the Clerk of Court consistent with the court's March 20, 2020 Administrative Order.
4. The Clerk of Court is directed to provide public notice of this Order and to take any necessary and proper actions to implement this Order.
