The Federal Circuit regularly hears arguments outside of Washington, D.C. as part of its nationwide jurisdiction and statutory requirement to provide "reasonable opportunities to citizens to appear before the court." The Federal Circuit has held sessions in Chicago, Illinois; New York City, New York; Los Angeles, California; Boston, Massachusetts; Baltimore, Maryland; Minneapolis, Minnesota; Dallas-Fort Worth, Texas; Wilmington, Delaware, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
